



## TASD Protocols for Symptomatic/Exposed Individuals

The following scenarios represent example protocols that will be utilized when individuals in the school setting have multiple symptoms of or have been contracted/exposed to COVID-19. These are given as examples and a baseline for action and notification. These protocols are guidelines and each situation will be handled on an individual basis.

**a. Individual (Student or Staff) exhibits multiple symptoms during the school day or is home with multiple symptoms.**

- Individual will be sent home with testing recommended or 48-hours symptom free with no medication.

**b. Individual has been tested for COVID-19- Awaiting Results.**

- Individual will remain home until results are received.

**c. Individual was exposed (outside or inside of school in close proximity) to a person who tested positive.**

- Vaccinated: CDC recommended 10-day masking; No quarantine.

\_ Unvaccinated: CDC recommended 5-day quarantine; 5-day masking w/no symptoms.

**d. Individual has tested positive for COVID-19.**

- Individual will remain home.

- Return after 5-days being asymptomatic or resolving symptoms.

- CDC recommended 5-day masking upon return.
