



## TASD Protocols for Symptomatic/Exposed Individuals

The following scenarios represent example protocols that will be utilized when individuals in the school setting have multiple symptoms of or have possibly been exposed to COVID-19. These are given as examples and a baseline for action and notification. These protocols are guidelines and each situation will be handled on an individual basis.

**a. Individual (Student or Staff) exhibits multiple symptoms during the school day or is home with multiple symptoms.**

- Individual will be sent home with testing recommended or 48-hours symptom free with no medication.

**b. Individual has been tested for COVID-19- Awaiting Results.**

- Individual will remain home until results are received.

**c. Individual was directly exposed (outside of school or at school in close proximity) to a person who tested positive.**

- CDC recommended 10-Day quarantine.

**d. Individual was indirectly exposed (outside of school or at school but not close proximity) to a person who tested positive.**

- Able to remain in school.

**e. Individual has tested positive for COVID-19.**

- Individual will remain home

- Return after 10 days with 48-hours no symptoms or negative test result after 10 days.

**f. Vaccinated individual is exposed to a positive individual.**

- No symptoms: CDC recommended 14-day masking & testing after 3-5 days.

- Symptoms: Remain at home & CDC recommended testing. Return 48 hours no symptoms.
