



TASD Protocols for Symptomatic/Exposed Individuals

The following scenarios represent example protocols that will be utilized when individuals in the school setting have multiple symptoms of or have been contracted/exposed to COVID-19. These are given as examples and a baseline for action and notification. These protocols are guidelines and each situation will be handled on an individual basis.

a. Individual (Student or Staff) exhibits multiple symptoms during the school day or is home with multiple symptoms.

- Individual will be sent home with testing recommended or 48-hours symptom free with no medication.

b. Individual has been tested for COVID-19- Awaiting Results.

- Individual will remain home until results are received.

c. Individual was exposed (outside or inside of school in close proximity) to a person who tested positive.

- Vaccinated: CDC recommended 10-day masking; No quarantine.

_ Unvaccinated: CDC recommended 5-day quarantine; 5-day masking w/no symptoms.

d. Individual has tested positive for COVID-19.

- Individual will remain home.

- Return after 5-days being asymptomatic or resolving symptoms.

- CDC recommended 5-day masking upon return.
